

An Important Note from the MTC (Ministry Team Council):

We want to remind everyone that the church building is still closed. We hope to return to in-person services in the summer of 2021, at the earliest. Church leadership will assess the situation every month and will keep the congregation informed of any changes. **Leadership has agreed to allow volunteers (who are doing the work of the church) into the building for limited visits. Entrance to the building will be handled case by case and visiting the church will require scheduling time with the church office.** There are special protocols to keep other volunteers and church staff safe. Healthy Procedures for Volunteers Entering the Church Building *Keeping Us All Safe and Healthy*

Plan ahead prior to coming to the building

-Email the church office to schedule your visit to the church at admin@firstuomaha.org.

The office must make sure that no one else will be entering or occupying the space you plan to use.

-Please plan ahead! Give the church office as much notice as possible, preferably at least four days in advance. The church office will work with our custodian and staff to make sure space is available and that it will be thoroughly cleaned between visitors.

For the protection of yourself

-DON'T come into the church building if you feel ill or have a fever.

- Come by yourself. We are not allowing groups. Exception: Auction Team is allowed two volunteers to enter the Common Room to prepare for online auction.

-Wear masks that cover both nose and mouth.

-Enter and exit through the side door (door closest to the garden) only.

-DO NOT use the kitchen.

- Only enter the room you have booked. Do NOT enter the office or religious education wing or other parts of the building you haven't booked.

If restroom breaks are needed

- Please use the restroom before you arrive. If you must use the restroom in the church, please use the nursery restroom (Common Room level, next to nursery and elevator).

- After using the restroom, please wipe down toilet handle and faucets and inner door handles and anything else you touched in the bathroom with the provided disinfecting wipes.

On leaving the building

- Please exit at the time you scheduled.
- Exit through the garden side door.
- Before you leave the building, use disinfecting wipes provided in each room to wipe down anything you touched: chair backs, table surfaces, books, door handles, light switches.
